




***Bring a small nutritious snack & drink each day**

***All lost & found items will be put in the Community Programs Office & if not claimed by the end of the summer, will be donated to Harbour House shelter**


***Parents/Guardians, must sign both in & out at drop off & pick up to ensure safety. Registration & waiver information must be filled out prior to attending camp**




